The constitutional basis for land reform is found in section 25(7) of the Constitution which states that a person or community that has been dispossessed of property after June 19, 1913 due to racially discriminatory laws or practices is entitled to, to the extent provided by an Act of Parliament, either to restitution of that property or equitable redress.
