Conduction aphasia has also been called central aphasia, disorganized execution of the encoding program related to disturbed auditory feedback, repetition aphasia, and afferent motor aphasia. The primary function of language that is affected is the repetition of speech, whereas comprehension and production tend to be much less impaired.
