The word "cotton" originated from the Arabic term *al qutn*, which became in Spanish *algodón* and cotton in English.

The Domestication History of Cotton (Gossypium)

The cotton gin, patented by American-born inventor Eli Whitney in 1794, revolutionized the cotton industry by greatly speeding up the tedious process of removing seeds and husks from cotton fiber. Similar to today's massive machines, Whitney's cotton gin used hooks to draw unprocessed cotton through a small-mesh screen that separated the fiber from seeds and husks.
