In Historical Figure of Jesus, Sanders does not set out a strict methodology for evaluating the authenticity of each pericope ("story bit") in the Gospels. His philosophy is to assemble as much social, political, economic and religious contextual information as possible regarding the life and times of Jesus of Nazareth, and then read the Gospels and Paul in that light (with a bit of help from Josephus).
